SUBJECT: Public Hearing of Proposed Student Fees for FY 2021

As specified in State Board of Education policy V.R.2.a., this letter serves as initial notice of a public hearing to be held at 3:00 PM on Wednesday, February 19, 2020 to gather input on proposed student tuition and fees to become effective with the Fall 2020 semester. The hearing will be held in Sacajawea Hall Room 112. Students wishing to submit written testimony should send their comments to the Office of the Vice President for Finance and Administration in the Administration Building on the Lewiston campus.

This proposal includes an increase to nonresident tuition of \$130 per semester (a 2.0% increase) and to Asotin County nonresident tuition of \$40 per semester (a 2.0% increase). No other increases are proposed, thus no increase to resident tuition or fees (student activity, facility, and technology fees). Revenue generated will be used to support institutional operations.

This letter should also serve as a request to publish the attached Notice of Public Hearing in *The Pathfinder*. Any assistance you can provide us in notifying students of the hearing is greatly appreciated. This notice and a detailed list of proposed tuition and fee changes will appear on the LCSC Budget Office web site for the next few weeks at: <http://www.lcsc.edu/budget>. Additionally, descriptions of the student activity, facility and technology fees and their uses can also be found at this site.
