Briefly describe the nature of the request

Lewis-Clark State College proposes the creation of a fully online graduate certificate program that will award a Nursing Management and Leadership Certificate. The proposed program will operate under the guidelines of SBOE Policy V.R. as it pertains to wholly on-line programs. The certificate consists entirely of existing on-line courses from the on-line BS Business Administration with focus in Health Care Management partnership program in conjunction with the Nursing & Health Sciences Division.

The proposed online Nursing Management and Leadership Certificate focuses on new management skill development and refinement of supervisory and leadership skills for current BSN-prepared nurses who would like to move into a more administrative role.

The proposed certificate is intended for current BSN RN practicing nurses who seek opportunities to advance their career in a management/leadership role. At the completion of the certificate, students will be well prepared for various nursing administration and leadership roles with a much more in-depth understanding of HR policies, personnel management, leadership styles, and budgetary processes.

The graduate certificate in Nursing Management and Leadership does not align perfectly to the job titles in the Department of Labor databases; however, the skills and knowledge gained in this certificate program will be beneficial to any health care facility where nursing management and medical hierarchy are present.

Catalog Description

The Nursing Management and Leadership Certificate will prepare you with the knowledge and skills needed to lead change and manage improved patient outcomes at all levels of healthcare organizations as you respond to the explosion of new technologies, increased diversity, and global health challenges in today's rapidly evolving healthcare system. The curriculum is designed to provide critical skills in policy development and evaluation, data analysis, population health, patient-centered care, and quality improvement and utilization. The program culminates in an internship that synthesizes prior learning through field experience and a capstone project.
